ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SCRUTINY OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

All the applications for the post of Assistant Professors have been scrutinized for eligibility as per UGC (minimum standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil/PhD degree) regulations, 2009 <http://www.ugc.ac.in/oldpdf/regulations/mphilphdclarification.pdf>. Some applicants claimed that UGC in its 472nd meeting has given exemption from the requirement of NET to the candidates who have either obtained PhD degree on or before 31st December, 2009 and candidates who had registered themselves for PhD degree on or before 10th July, 2009 and are subsequently awarded degree. However, as per UGC public notice, F.9-3/2010 (PS) dated 12th October, 2012 (http://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/5992428_publicnotice.pdf), it is clearly stated that:

“It has come to the notice of UGC that in the recent past, some of the universities and institutions have advertised the post of Lecturers/Assistant Professor without any stipulation regarding mandatory requirement of NET/SLET/SET as required by UGC Regulations, notified on 11.7.2009 and 18.9.2010. It has also been noticed by UGC that universities/institutions are relying on the Resolutions of the Commission in the 471st (<http://www.ugc.ac.in/oldpdf/commissiondecision/471.pdf>) and 472nd meeting (<http://www.ugc.ac.in/oldpdf/commissiondecision/472.pdf>) of the UGC held on 12.8.2010 & 27.9.2010. It is clarified and informed for the benefit of all concerned Universities/Institutions and other stake holders including prospective candidates that the above resolutions are merely the part of the process of deliberation by the Commission on the issue of minimum qualification for appointment and not a final decision required to be implemented. In fact, the Central Government vide its D.O. letter No.F.8-7/2010-U-I(A) dated 3rd November, 2010 did not concur with the said resolutions dated 12.8.2010 and 27.9.10 of the Commission.”

Thus, those candidates who have not qualified NET/SLET/SET but have done PhD in the relevant subject fulfilling the following conditions as contained in UGC (minimum standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil/PhD degree) regulations, 2009 are eligible for the post of Assistant Professor at DAV University:

- 1. Admission to PhD based on entrance examination**
- 2. PhD course work for a minimum period of one semester. This must include a course on Research Methodology.**
- 3. State level eligibility tests- SLET/SET etc. are valid nationwide if they were cleared 2002. After 2002, they are valid only in their respective states.**
